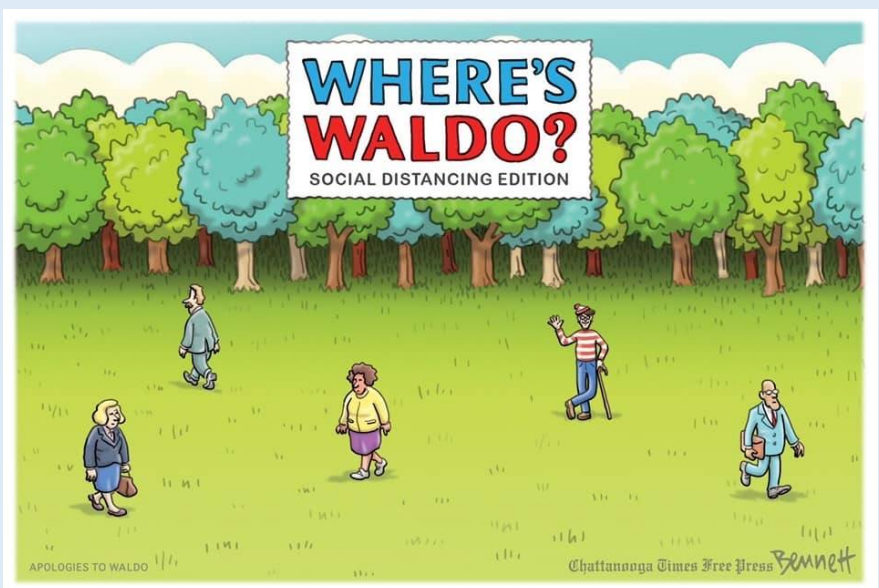
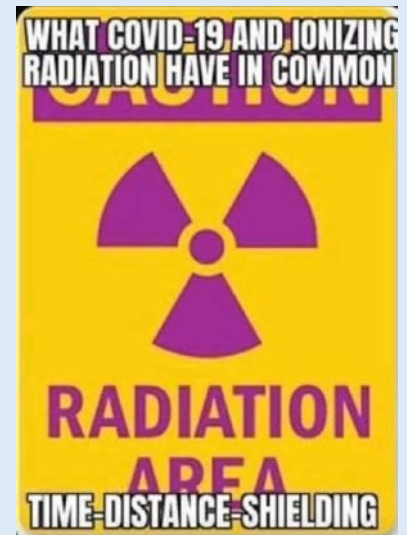

PROPOSAL UPDATES



In September 2019, AVESI, Inc. teamed with Conti Federal to bid the Welsbach FUSRAP project in NJ and our proposal was submitted on October 2nd. We were told in February that we were not one of the finalists, however the project has not yet been awarded. HGL/APTIM is still in the running for this Northeast project.

That same month we also submitted pricing and a commitment letter to team with APTIM on their proposal for the Decommissioning & Disposal of the SM-1 Nuclear Reactor Facility at Fort Belvoir, Virginia. Last week they were asked to provide a Best and Final Offer and resubmitted. This project has not yet been awarded.

In December 2019, APTIM requested a bid to support them on the loading, transport, dismantling and disposal of the Surface Ship Support Barge (SSSB). The SSSB was used by the Navy to service reactors and supporting refueling of nuclear-powered surface combatants at Newport News Shipbuilding. This project has not yet been awarded.

In January 2020, AVESI, Inc. completed its field investigation of the phosphate mining reclamation land in south Florida. AVESI surveyed approximately 1% of two residential neighborhoods near Lakeland, FL for a private firm. We are anticipating ongoing contracts to survey 100% of the neighborhoods.

In February 2020, AVESI Inc. signed a teaming agreement with HGL/APTIM to provide radiological support services for the USACE Luckey rebid in Luckey OH. The team is in the strategy stages and expecting the request for proposal to be issued next month. This project represents \$100M over a 10-year period. We hope to see an award by the end of 2020.

In March 2020, AVESI, Inc. signed a teaming agreement with ATI, Inc. in order to pursue a Pre-placed Remedial Action Contract (PRAC) contract out of the Omaha District for the USACE.

AVESI, Inc. is currently in negotiations with the USACE to perform dose and risk assessment support for the St Louis HGL contract. This opportunity would likely lead to additional dose and risk assessment work across the USACE/FUSRAP theater.

AVESI INC CORPORATE TRANSITION

We successfully transitioned ownership at the beginning of this year. This was a very tedious and time-consuming effort involving many hours of changing or updating registrations, corporate by-laws and federal and state notifications. This required the assistance of corporate lawyers, 2 corporate tax accounting firms and financial advisors. We are very proud to say the transition is complete.

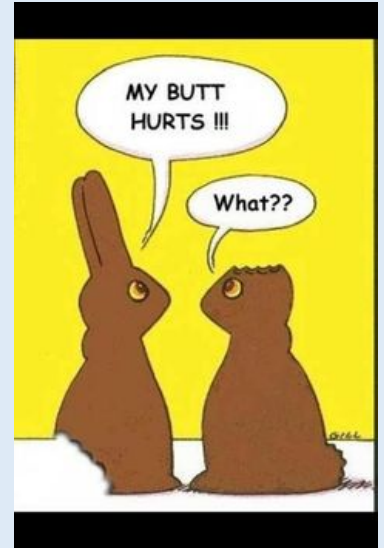
